

IDAHO'S 11TH ANNUAL PIGGY BANK BEAUTY CONTEST

February 22-26, 2021

In conjunction with America Saves week, The Idaho Financial Literacy Coalition will be hosting it's 11th Annual Piggy Bank Beauty Contest!

Contest Rules/Checklist:

- One entry per child in grades 3 through 6 in any school district, child care facility or after school program
- Size limitation: 12"x12"x12" or smaller
- Piggy does NOT have to be in the shape of a pig! This bank needs only to be able to hold change (You can dress up an existing bank!)
- Child must be involved in designing, making and/or decorating the pig at home and/or in school
- Drop off your piggy to any D.L.Evans Bank or Mountain America Credit Union Branch between February 22-26, 2021 (in conjunction with America Saves Week)
- **Each entry must include completed registration form and contact information for parent or legal guardian**
- Winners will be announced in March and publicly announced at the Governor's signing of his Financial Literacy Month in Idaho proclamation (Date is TBD in the Governor's Ceremonial Office)
- Pigs will be on display at partner locations! NOTE: Please do not write child's name in a visible place for identity protection
- Categories include: 1-funniest, 2-prettiest, 3-most creative and 4-celebrity look alike
- \$75 Scholarship to an IDeal - Idaho 529 College Savings Account given to each winner!

Ideas for Making a Piggy Bank

Piggy Bank Beauty Contest entries may measure no more than 12" in width, length or height, and they must be able to hold money (coins and bills). Otherwise, the child's imagination is the limit.

Please do NOT write the child's name on any conspicuous surface, so that judging may be fair and unbiased.

Judged categories include:

1. Funniest Piggy Bank
2. Prettiest Piggy Bank
3. Most Athletic Piggy Bank
4. Celebrity Look Alike Bank

Here are some ideas to consider when building a piggy bank:

Possible Materials for the Pig's Body*:

Coffee Cans with Plastic Lids

Glass Jars (Mason or Spaghetti Sauce, for example)

Paper Plate (Folded and Taped)

Plastic Bottles (soft drinks, water, etc.)

Tissue Boxes

Yogurt Containers

Other container measuring 12"x12"x12" or less

*Punch or cut a slot through the container or its lid to insert coins and/or bills

Additional Materials (Legs, Face, Decorations, etc.):

Construction Paper

Empty Toilet Paper or Paper Towel Rolls

Fabric

Finger Paint

Fuzz Balls

Glitter

Markers or Crayons

Pictures or Drawings

Pipe Cleaner

Ribbons & Buttons

Stamps

Stickers

Textured Paper

Yarn

Glue Stick or Elmer's Glue

History of the Piggy Bank Beauty Contest

The Idaho Financial Literacy Coalition started the Piggy Bank Beauty Contest in 2010 after the president at the time went to the National Jump\$tart Coalition State Leaders training in Washington DC. While there she had learned that other state coalitions were doing this and were very successful in promoting financial literacy and helping children to develop smart saving habits early. In past years the Coalition has given \$50 awards to 4 students and to the teacher of the winning students.

Since 2016, IDEal - Idaho 529 College Savings Program has been our sponsor, giving a \$75.00 scholarship to each winner to start saving for college. This means the Coalition and Sponsors have donated over \$2300.00 to students and teachers in Idaho!

Each year we celebrate in the Governor's ceremonial office where the students are presented with their awards.

The IDEal – Idaho 529 College Savings Program would like to award the scholarship to the winners within 14 days from when they are notified. This requires opening an IDEal - Idaho 529 College Savings account to receive funding.
